



Bridge Resource Management

Aim:

The aim of the course is to provide the guidance for masters and officers- in- charge of a navigational watch on the skills required for effective bridge resource management.

Objectives:

Specifically, at the end of the course the trainee must:

- Explain the knowledge of bridge resource management principles including:
 1. allocation, assignment, and prioritization of resources
 2. effective communication
 3. assertiveness and leadership
 4. obtaining and maintaining situational awareness
 5. consideration of team experience
- Demonstrate clear, concise communications and acknowledgements (at all times) in a seaman-like manner
- Demonstrate the allocation, assignment and prioritization of resources
- Demonstrate the importance of ensuring the effectiveness of communication between bridge team members.
- Demonstrate effective information exchange
- Demonstrate appropriate challenges and responses
- Demonstrate the ability to maintain situational awareness in complex situations

Target Audience:

This training program is primarily intended to guide the masters and officers- in- charge of a navigational watch on the skills required for effective bridge resource management.
